

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GUILFORD COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO ADD A REFERENDUM TO THE NOVEMBER, 2002 BALLOT ON FOUR-YEAR STAGGERED TERMS OF OFFICE FOR SUMMERFIELD TOWN COUNCIL

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute 160A-102 authorizes the Town Council to amend the Town Charter by ordinance under the option set forth by North Carolina General Statute 160A-101(4); and

WHEREAS, the Summerfield Town Council deems it suitable to allow a Referendum before the people to vote either For or Against the Summerfield Town Charter amendment to change the terms of office for Town Council members from two-year terms to staggered four-year terms; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority contained in North Carolina General Statute 160A-102 the Guilford County Board of Elections is hereby requested to add a Referendum to the November, 2002, ballot to allow a vote before the Summerfield Town people to approve or disapprove the amendment to the Town Charter for four-year staggered terms of office for Town Council members; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance for the Charter change for Town Council members' terms of office from two-year terms to staggered four-year terms shall be effective only if approved by a vote of the people.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SUMMERFIELD that pursuant to the authority contained in General Statute 160A-102 the ballot for Town Charter Amendment to change the terms of office of Summerfield Town Council members from two-year terms to four-year staggered terms shall state the proposition as follows:

Shall the ordinance amending the Charter of the Town of Summerfield to provide for four-year staggered terms for members of the Town of Summerfield Council beginning with the regular municipal election in 2003 be approved?
