

RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN  
CREATING A REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of North Carolina has enacted the Solid Waste Management Act of 1989, Chapter 130A, Article 9, Part 2A of the General Statutes of North Carolina and other laws pertaining to solid waste; and

WHEREAS, said legislation provide that each county, either individually or in cooperation with its municipalities, should develop a comprehensive county solid waste management plan consistent with the State's comprehensive solid waste plan, including provisions which address the State's recycling goal; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has enacted legislation providing for the creation of regional solid waste management authorities among units of local government in North Carolina, including legislation being codified as Chapter 153A, Article 22 of the General Statutes; and

WHEREAS, SUMMERFIELD has conferred with other jurisdictions located in the predominant area of the State of North Carolina, and after due and diligent consideration, desires to join with other jurisdictions to create a Solid Waste Management Authority in the best interest of all jurisdictions in addressing future needs relating to solid waste.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the SUMMERFIELD TOWN COUNCIL by the adoption of this resolution, does hereby declare its intent to participate in the satisfactory creation and operation of a Solid Waste Authority subject to the adoption of formal resolutions and agreements at the appropriate time. Staff is directed to proceed promptly with formation and implementation of said Authority.
