**NEW BUSINESS: (Interview for Summerfield Town Attorney):**

**A. 6:30 pm – 8:00 pm.....Wolfe & Associates**

Representative present from the firm of Wolfe & Associates was Anargiros N. “Jerry” Kontos.

He stated he would be the main conduit between the town and the firm.

Mayor Brown, Council members and the Town Administrator asked questions of Mr. Kontos about other firm members, contracts, franchise service experience, general municipal law, zoning and planning experience, state law knowledge and updates, client development, professional organizations, Guilford County and Summerfield Ordinances, any conflicts of interest, availability, code enforcement, mediation and billing rates.

There appeared to be no conflicts of interests with property or client interest.

In his closing statements, Kontos stated he is interested in public service with results and wants to make a difference.
