
**ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWN CHARTER OF SUMMERFIELD
AS SET FORTH IN THE RESOLUTION OF INTENT DATED JULY 10, 2007,
SUBJECT TO VOTE OF THE PEOPLE.**

WHEREAS a public hearing having been held on the 14th day of August 2007, with respect to the proposed Amendment of the Charter of Summerfield to adopt a Council-Manager form of government as previously described in the Resolution of Intent dated July 10, 2007; and,


WHEREAS the council of the Town of Summerfield hereby adopts this Ordinance changing the form of government in the Town of Summerfield from a Mayor-Council form of government to a Council-Manager as that form of government is defined by N.C.G.S. § 160A-147 *et. seq.* and,

WHEREAS the Council, by the discretion afforded it pursuant N.C.G.S. § 160A-102, wishes to make this Ordinance subject to a vote of the people, the Council hereby calls for this prospective Ordinance to be placed on the November 6, 2007 ballot in the form attached hereto, for the purpose of submitting this ordinance to a vote. The result of said election shall be binding on the Town of Summerfield.
