

**RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE EFFORTS OF THE CITIZENS OF SUMMERFIELD TO RESTORE AND PROTECT THE STREAM BASIN OF THE MEARS FORK**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Summerfield supports the conservation of its water resources and environmentally sensitive regions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Summerfield supports and encourages the citizen initiated efforts to restore and protect the environmentally sensitive wetlands along the stream basin known as Mears Fork, which has its headwaters in Summerfield just east of route US 220 and a course that is north of and roughly parallel to the section of Highway 150 West east of US 220, which is a part of the Cape Fear River Basin; and

**WHEREAS**, the Clean Water Management Trust Fund, administered by the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources is seeking to preserve and restore clean water for the state of North Carolina.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:** The Town Council of the Town of Summerfield supports and encourages these efforts of its citizens to restore and protect the stream basin of Mears Fork. The protection of water resources and environmentally sensitive wetlands is critical to the long-term interest of the Town of Summerfield and its residents.
