Discussion of Property Tax Collection and Animal Shelter Agreement between Guilford County and City of Greensboro


Brandt stated the County and City reached an agreement consisting of the city paying a rate of .06 for tax collection and would pay nothing for the Animal Shelter, and the county would pay an additional \$200,000 to the city for the library.

Following much discussion, including debate on whether to send letters to the county commissioners asking for consideration, it was decided by consensus to gather more information, including the feelings of other municipalities, prior to taking any action. Another Special Call meeting was scheduled for Monday February 21, 2011, 4:30pm at Town Hall to further discuss the matter.
