A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE ACTIONS OF THE TOWN OF OAK RIDGE AND THE TOWN OF STOKESDALE TO OPPOSE THE EXPANSION OF THE PIEDMONT SANITARY LANDFILL

WHEREAS, the Town of Oak Ridge and the Town of Stokesdale have indicated their concern and opposition to the expansion of the Piedmont Sanitary Landfill into Guilford County; and

WHEREAS, each Town of Oak Ridge and Stokesdale are concerned about the close proximity such landfill expansion would have to its boundaries, and for the impact on its commun. with respect to the health, safety and welfare, together with the adverse effect on it citizens' land values; and


WHEREAS, Town of Summerfield recognizes the above concerns of Oak Ridge and Stokesdale as valid and justified notwithstanding the publicly stated need of the City of Greensboro to resite its present solid waste disposal facility.


