

**A RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO A STUDY BY NORTH  
CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OF  
REROUTING TRUCK TRAFFIC ON A PORTION OF  
SUMMERFIELD ROAD (SR 2117) LOCATED WHOLLY WITHIN  
THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SUMMERFIELD,  
NORTH CAROLINA**

**WHEREAS**, The residents of Summerfield Road (SR2117) have requested a study as to the feasibility of rerouting truck traffic from the point of Pleasant Ridge Road (SR2133), north to NC Highway 150 (Oak Ridge Road), south to Auburn Road (SR2204) because of the potential damage said traffic could cause to Historical Structures and Buildings and the high volume of traffic in this area;

**WHEREAS**, at the completion of the study, the North Carolina Department Of Transportation will submit their findings to the Town Council;

**WHEREAS**, The Town Council of Summerfield as the governing body for the citizens of the Town of Summerfield will review and either approve, disapprove or recommend amending said study;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:** The Town Council on behalf of the Town of Summerfield, North Carolina does herewith, after due consideration and deliberation and without any objection being heard, concur and consent to the study of rerouting truck traffic from a point at Pleasant Ridge Road (SR2133) north to NC Highway 150 (Oak Ridge Road)
