



**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE NORTH CAROLINA
MOUNTAINS TO SEA TRAIL ALTERNATIVE ROUTE LINKS IN SUMMERFIELD,
NORTH CAROLINA**

WHEREAS, the Town of Summerfield is committed to providing diverse and excellent recreational opportunities for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina plans for a Mountains-to-Sea Trail (MST) that will provide transportation, recreation and tourism and will highlight a wide variety of historic and natural resources for all North Carolinians; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Summerfield has an adopted trails map that indicates a multi-use trail following the route of the abandoned Atlantic and Yadkin rail bed and the Town is participating in intergovernmental planning for trails and the planning and development of the Atlantic and Yadkin Greenway (A&Y Greenway) with Guilford County, Stokesdale, Greensboro, and others and

WHEREAS, the Piedmont Land Conservancy has developed a plan for the Piedmont Greenway to traverse Summerfield from Lake Higgins to Salem Lake and both the A&Y Greenway and Piedmont Greenway have been identified as alternative routes of the MST that would provide trail access and connectivity to many Summerfield neighborhoods and residents, and provide economic development potential as a trailhead community for local businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SUMMERFIELD:

- 1) That the Town of Summerfield supports both alternative routes for the MST through the Town.
- 2) That the Piedmont Greenway be added to the official Town of Summerfield trails map.
- 3) That this resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
