APRIL 21, 2003**

**\*\*NOTE:** In open session, Jane Doggett made a motion to recess to executive session at 8:35 pm to discuss property matters. There was no discussion. The motion was seconded by Bob Williams and passed unanimously.

It was reported that the Sessoms Building at the corner of Hwy 220 and Summerfield is not for sale because the owner feels he can't find another building like it.

There was discussion about Clyde Shreve house on Highway 220 with 8 acres which was visible and suitable but is on a hill and the lay of the land is not good. The asking price is \$275,000.

There was discussion about existing zoning and necessary permitting for various properties in conjunction with their possible availability.

There was discussion about looking toward Hwy. 150 and the idea of a joint plan with Oak Ridge and Stokesdale for a substation.

There was discussion about various other properties that might possibly be available and it was mentioned that the 1.4 acre Jones property next door to the fire station appears available.

By majority consensus, Council adjourned from closed session back to open meeting at 9:12 PM.
