

**SUMMERFIELD RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION  
SUMMERFIELD COLLECTOR STREET PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Summerfield Development Ordinance (Article 2-1.12(b)) refers to a "Collector Street Plan," generally defined as an adopted plan "for streets not shown on the Thoroughfare Plan, showing collector and, if appropriate, lower classification streets in the planning area;" and

**WHEREAS**, collector street designation is used in determining building setbacks, street right-of-way widths, permissible uses, sidewalk installation requirements, and other planning purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, Summerfield has not adopted a Collector Street Plan to assign said designations in a systematic and comprehensive manner; and

**WHEREAS**, A Draft Collector Street Plan was prepared in conjunction with the development of the **Greensboro Urban Area 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan**; and

**WHEREAS**, MPO staff have worked cooperatively with the City of Greensboro, Guilford County, MPO Area incorporated towns, NCDOT, and other stakeholders to prepare a comprehensive Collector Street Plan for the jurisdictions situated within the MPO's Metropolitan Area Boundary, in response to land use regulation and transportation system needs; and

**WHEREAS**, development of the Collector Street Plan incorporated a public involvement process that fully complies with the MPO Public Involvement Plan, and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Advisory Committee of the Greensboro Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization urges the governing bodies within the MPO area to adopt and implement said Collector Street Plan.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Summerfield Town Council adopts the Summerfield Collector Street Plan.
