RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE GUILFORD COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO PROVIDE  
FOR ABSENTEE VOTING IN MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS FOR THE TOWN OF SUMMERFIELD

WHEREAS, on 26 May, 1975 the General Assembly of North Carolina enacted statewide legislation effective 1 July, 1975 to permit absentee voting in any municipal election, including a primary general election or referendum conducted by the county board of elections, upon request of the municipal governing body to said board of elections;

WHEREAS in the opinion of the Town Council, it is deemed in the best interest of the Town to request that the Guilford County Board of Elections provide for absentee voting in municipal elections for the Town of Summerfield;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SUMMERFIELD:

That, pursuant to authority contained in G.S. 163-302 (a), effective July 1, 1975, the Guilford County Board of Elections is hereby requested to provide for absentee voting in municipal elections for the Town of Summerfield.
