**WHEREAS, Summerfield Town Council is concerned that the Town is affected by drought conditions which began in 1998 and has become much more pronounced by August of 2002; and**


**WHEREAS, some town residents are experiencing dry well conditions and are having to drill new and deeper wells to avoid water shortages under the current drought conditions; and**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SUMMERFIELD:**

**That all citizens are urged to conserve our most precious water resource by individual conservation measures in and outside our homes in recognition that our ground water is a valuable resource that must be conserved and protected to help assure an adequate water supply for today and for the future.**
