WHEREAS, The people of the Oak Ridge Community have petitioned the State of North Carolina for the right to vote to incorporate their community or not, and

WHEREAS, The Town of Summerfield, North Carolina was incorporated, in part, because it is our belief that communities have the right to protect their historical identity and to provide local control for local issues, and


WHEREAS, We believe in the phrase from the Declaration of Independence of the United States of America which states governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed;
