Neither the Town of Summerfield nor Founders' Day Committee members are responsible for any accident, injury, or damage to any parade participant or equipment. The town assigns parade positions and retains the right to determine the suitability of entries. Entrants are expected to comply with their assigned position in the parade. Units will begin assembling two hours prior to the parade start (after reporting to Summerfield Elementary School). Participants must be in their assigned spot 30 minutes prior to parade start time. Please observe appropriate dress code; this is a family event.

Children must have adult supervision. Parents or group leaders may sign waivers for underage participants. **Absolutely no standing on the back of moving vehicles** – violators will be asked to leave the parade lineup for non-compliance with safety requirements. Equestrian entries (horses, mules, ponies) must provide a method of clean-up behind animals both before and during the parade. All participants riding bicycles or motorcycles are required to wear helmets per current NC helmet laws.
