RESOLUTION NAME: **SURPLUS OFFICE FURNITURE**

WHEREAS, G.S. 160A-266 establishes a method to dispose of personal property and for the use of electronic advertising for electronic auction of surplus property under 160A-270(c); and,

WHEREAS, the local governing board may authorize one or more officials to declare the property surplus and to dispose of the property efficiently and economically at a fair market value following all procedure as set forth in G.S. 160A-266(c); and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council is granted authority to declare property surplus and under G.S. 160A-270(c) may advertise electronically the sale of any personal property; and,

WHEREAS, the Summerfield Town Council approved a procedure for disposing of property valued at less than \$5000 (RES-2010-010) that gives the Town Manager authorization to declare property as surplus and dispose of it, but also reads: "no surplus property may be donated to any individual or organization except by resolution of the Town Council";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Summerfield Town Council hereby donates the following items declared by the Town Manager as surplus using the conditions set forth in RES-2010-010: 1) inventory items 000102 (an unlockable Finance Officer desk) and 000134 (a matching bookshelf) to Lawings Transportation, and, 2) inventory item 000081 (an unlockable 2-drawer cabinet) to Amber Grimes. These three items were of minimal value and needed to be removed to make room at town hall. A third piece of the furniture set, item 000083 (a broken 2-drawer filing cabinet), was discarded.
