SUMMERFIELD ATHLETIC PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- PARK OPEN FROM 9:00am to 5:00pm AND BY RESERVATION
 - PER SUMMERFIELD ORDINANCE 2010-005, THE FOLLOWING IS PROHIBITED FROM ALL PARK AREAS: PETS/ANIMALS (except service animals), TOBACCO USE, FIREWORKS, HUNTING, FIREARMS/WEAPONS, ALCOHOL/DRUGS, SOLICITATION, DISORDERLY CONDUCT
 - NO CLIMBING ON FENCES, GATES OR POLES, OR MISUSE OF EQUIPMENT
 - ALL MOTORIZED VEHICLES AND BICYCLES MUST REMAIN ON ESTABLISHED ROADWAYS AND IN DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS
 - NO ROLLER SKATES/BLADES, RIDING TOYS, OR SKATE BOARDS ALLOWED
 - RULE VIOLATORS MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES
 - ALL TRASH/RECYCLING MUST BE DISPOSED OF IN APPROPRIATE CONTAINERS


