

Located in the center of town adjacent to Summerfield Elementary School, *Summerfield Community Park* provides numerous recreational opportunities for the community including playgrounds, picnic shelters, and an orienteering course. Park facilities include ADA accessible trails, a wildlife overlook, exercise stations, and a fishing pier. The park also features the VFW Post 7999 Veterans' Memorial and an outdoor amphitheatre in which a variety of programs are held throughout the year. Whether you have just an hour or all day, we welcome you to enjoy the park!

Summerfield Community Park Rules and Regulations

To reserve the **Community Center**, contact Kent Dowdy at (336) 944-4212.

To reserve **Park Facilities**, call Town Hall at (336) 643-8655

- Park hours are sunrise to sunset.
- Animals must be on a leash. Please clean up after your pet.
- All motorized vehicles must remain on established roadways and in designated parking areas.
- Fishing is permitted in designated areas only.
- Trash must be deposited in appropriate receptacles.
- Users must remain on marked trails.

The following are prohibited: alcoholic beverages, illegal drug possession or usage, firearms, hunting, misuse of equipment or facilities, archery equipment, disorderly conduct, mini-bikes, go-carts, ATVs, motorbikes, trash dumping, skates, rollerblading, skateboarding, boating, swimming, amplified music, and horses.


