During the meeting of the Summerfield Town Council on February 11, 2014, the following action was taken:

- **Agenda item 4:** approval of the consent agenda, including the meeting agenda, minutes of the 1/9, 1/14, and 1/30 meetings, and the financial report (unanimous)
- **Agenda item 9. Animal Control Ordinance revisions:** adopt revised Guilford County Animal Control Ordinance (revision prohibits unattended tethering of dogs) (unanimous)
- **Agenda item 10. Public Nuisance Ordinance revisions:** table the item and rework the proposed ordinance based on what other rural areas have in place (unanimous)
- **Agenda item 11 Abandoned, Nuisance, and Junked Motor Vehicle Ordinance:** table consideration of the proposed Ordinance until it is edited to align reasonably with what is appropriate for Summerfield (unanimous)
- **Agenda item 12 A. Zoning Board reappointments/appointment:**
 - reappoint Jeff Davis as a voting member of the Zoning Board (unanimous)
 - reappoint Scott Henson as a Zoning Board alternate (unanimous)
 - appoint Dwayne Crawford as a Zoning Board alternate (carried 4 to 1, Barnes opposed)
- **Agenda item 12 B. I-73 Municipal Agreement with NCDOT (Edgefield Road to Haw River):** acknowledge receipt of the NCDOT Municipal Agreement for Project R-2413 A&B
- **Agenda item 12 C. A&Y Greenway Design and RFQ process (Hwy 220 pedestrian tunnel to Centerfield Rd):** directed Whitaker to work with the MPO and the Trails and Open Space Committee to begin the process of soliciting qualified design firms and bring pricing information back to council (unanimous)
- **Agenda item 15:** move the 2014 Founders' Day event to Summerfield Athletic Park provided the committee can work out the logistics
